STUDENT TYPE

Note: it's important you read and get familiar with the school policies as the management will not hesitate to act if this code of conducts are breeched, ignorance will also not be condoned as an excuse.

1. Student Type

- **1.1 Full Time Students:** Full-time students are permitted, based on their fee and program, to come to school from Mondays to Fridays.
- **1.2 Part-time Students**: Executive students can attend school on Saturdays and other weekdays. Only weekday students have 3 lectures per week.
- **1.3 Foundation Student:** Only on Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays can foundation students attend lectures.
- **1.4 Internship:** All Academy graduates with a minimum 75% final grade are eligible for a paid internship. Internship applicants should email gmytfashionacademy@gmail.com for approval.
- **1.5 Class Stages:** The GMYT Fashion Academy curriculum is designed to equip students with fashion skills. The curriculum progresses students across competencies as follows:
- Newbies / Newestbies
- Freshers
- Beginners
- Intermediate / Advanced

- **2. Induction**: The GMYT induction for new students and any Academy event are required for all students. Any student who, due to uncontrollable circumstances, may miss the induction or any of the above events must send a notice 72 hours before the event and get approval before leaving.
- **3. Graduation:** Every GMYT student must pay for and attend the graduation ceremony/fashion show (GAHAWARDS). This is a required part of GMYT Fashion Academy's program for certification.

CONTINUOUS ASSESSMENT

- 4. Continuous Assessments / Examinations: All students must participate in tests, exams, collections, and projects for continuous assessment and final certification. Students who miss continuous assessments without an approved reason face dismissal and/or decertification.
- **4.1 Projects:** The Academy expects all students to complete a project during its monthly Fabric week. All students must submit projects as required by the Academy.
- All students must participate in group projects and submit their logbooks afterward.
- A student who does not pay but participated will not be cleared by his/her supervisor.



STUDENT TYPE

- A student who pays for the project but did not participate will also not be cleared by the supervisor.
- A student who fails to follow any of these instructions must complete the project unsupervised and submit it to the HOD.
- Any student who doesn't participate in a class or academy project won't be allowed in class until they submit double the assigned project.
- 4.2 Cut Off Mark: GMYT Fashion Academy grades all assignments, classwork, and projects. End of program, all students must meet the Academy's cut-off mark. Graduation requirements are 75%. Students who miss practical sessions will have to pay extra fees and retake them.

4.3 Graduation/Certification

4.3.1 In addition to the above provisions, the following criteria must be met for all GMYT Fashion Academy students to graduate and be certified:

- Financial Clearance form
- Proof of minimum attendance requirement for course type (75%).
- Proof of no equipment damage clearance form
- Proof of return of all academy property(s) including keys, Identity cards etc.
- · Submission of not-less-than 3 body forms or manneguins to the school in union.
- Submission of supervisor grading for final Showcase.

- Any student that does not showcase a collection on the runway will not be entitled to a certificate.
- 4.4 Testimonials: All students are required to give testimonials within three months of the program's start.

4.5 Submission Of Graduation Outfits: Students must submit their graduation outfits in advance so the school can prepare.

KITS



5.KITS

Students' kit package are made available upon payment of required fees to the accounting department.

5.1 Starter Kits: The Academy provides students with basic sewing kits for class work, but students are responsible for lost kits.

- 5.2 Uniformity: Students must buy all kits in school to promote uniform materials/tools.
- 5.3 Procedure For Kits Purchase: To buy kits from the store, students can:
- Send the accounting department a list of kit items and request pricing.
- Once the Accounting department responds to the initial request, students can pay.
- The student must then request the kits by mail, attaching proof of payment.



A student can also pay for the kits in the accounting department and pick them up with their receipts.

5.4 Illustration Kits: Illustration classes require FREE illustration kits. Class only allows approved illustration kits.



SEWING MACHINE

- 6. Sewing Machine: GMYT Fashion Academy's empowerment program provides sewing machines to certain students on predefined terms and conditions. All students understand and agree that the sewing machine is not included in their program fees. All students understand that the sewing machine is issued as part of GMYT Fashion Academy's corporate social responsibility, through her empowerment scheme.
- A student can only receive a sewing machine if they pay in full at registration. Installmentpaying students are NOT eligible for free machines.
- To be eligible for the sewing machine scheme, students must be present at the induction ceremony.
- The sewing machine is only available on induction day (not sooner or later).
- On the day of the induction, the prospective student must personally collect the sewing machine.

- Only WEEKDAY students who meet the payment policy criteria are eligible for free machines.
- Only 12 months are eligible for sewing machine
- A student who meets the above requirements must write to the accounting department and attach proof of full payment to the school.

6.1 Demurrage: Any student who qualifies for a sewing machine but doesn't pick it up must pay a 2,000-naira-per-day demurrage fee.

FEES



7.1 Non-refundable/non-covertable Of Fees: The academy does not refund, transfer, or convert tuition or other payments. All school fees are non-refundable and must be paid in full within 3 months of first payment.

7.2 Installment Payment

Installments can be paid over six, nine, or 12 months program and once-off payment for three months. All installment fees are due within 3 months. Otherwise, the student must withdraw from school. Your tuition is non-transferable and non-refundable.



7.3 Extension Of Duration

After two weeks, students can extend their program. Only the difference between the current and desired duration is paid. After 2 weeks, program extensions cost #100,000 for the first month and #50,000 for subsequent months.

7.4 Deferments

If a student cannot continue their program at the Academy due to health, pregnancy, family death, or other issues, they may opt to change their program through the GMYT Freezing of Account Procedures. All students with a valid reason may request a 3-month deferment.

- Freezing or postponing must be based on 50,000 or as evaluated by management.
- Students must freeze/defer accounts following these steps.:
- Student must apply to the accounts office for account/course freezing/deferment, stating start date, end date, and reason for absence.
- Mail application to account department two weeks before deferment.
- Before making payments, students must get deferment approval.
- Students must pay for course freezing upon management approval. Pay at accounting office, When you return to school, a new ID will be issued.

NB: if no approval is given the request is void, nonetheless with/without approval all students must graduate within same year of registration/admission.

7.5. Identity Card

Always wear your ID. Any student who violates this will not be allowed in school and can be suspended if it becomes a pattern; new students are entitled to a temporary school ID (kindly visit the account office for issuance)

7.6 Loss Of ID Card

Reissuing of the school ID card if lost cost #10,000.

7.7 Freezing Of Account

Note: To freeze your account,

- 1. you would need apply, stating when you are leaving and your expected return date.
- 2. Make your payment
- 3. Submit your ID card as a new one would be issued to you on your return to the school.

NB: If no approval is given the request is void, nonetheless with/without approval all students must graduate within same year of registration/admission.

7.8 Non-commencement or Non-completion of Course

No refund or fee reduction will be given if a student doesn't complete the course. Each student must complete a certain number of hours before taking practical and exams.



COURSE FORM

8 Course Form: All course forms, including two passports, one portrait photo in soft and hard copy, must be submitted before resumption. A grace period of two weeks is given, so student registration is void after two weeks. The academy gives each student a Student Course Form after full registration payment. The course form must be kept for all Academy activities.

GMYT Fashion Academy shall not be responsible for the loss or damage of any course form in the possession of any students. GMYT Fashion Academy shall not be required to duplicate the contents of any student in the future resulting from the loss or damage of any course form.

- **8.1 MD's/ Hos Remark:** All students must submit their log book monthly for sighting and comments.
- **8.2 Loss Of Course Form/log Book:** New course form/logbook costs #10,000 if misplaced, so it's important that students take care of it. This is the official book approved by the school for Documentation and to track students' progress, so any student without a logbook will not be allowed in class and no facilitator will attend to him/her.
- **8.3 Logbooks:** All students are expected to sign in all their daily activities in their logbooks and ensure that their instructors sign on it. Failure to do this will result in suspension.

- **8.4 Syllabus:** Non-completion of the program's syllabus means no final exam. Non-completion of the syllabus will cost extra.
- **8.5 MD's Office:** Students cannot walk into the MD's office without permission from the customer service desk. If a student needs the MD/attention CEO's urgently, he/she can email @ceo4gmytfashionacademy.com or use the course form.
- **8.6 Meeting**: Only in emergencies will the MD/CEO attend student meetings.
- **8.7 Resumption And Closing Time:** 9am-3pm are class hours. After their session with facilitators, students should go to the VIP room.
- **8.8 Absenteeism:** Students must write a letter to the class facilitators or HOD explaining why they need to miss class. Courses are continuous unless the MD/CEO NB approves a break. In cases of illness, missed days/weeks/months will be refunded.

CONDUCT



Any student who misses fabric week must create two outfits unassisted; the HOD will provide the styles. A student must also get a model, go to a studio, and take professional photos of both projects before submitting them to the school on a 500g hard drive.





CONDUCTS

10 Discipline And Disciplinary Procedures: The academy's management may suspend, dismiss, or expel students with or without notice for cause. In this case, management's decision is final and no fees will be refunded.

10.1 Damages & Loss

If a student loses or damages school property, other students in the same department are expected to report it and identify the offender. Failure to do so will result in a penalty for the entire class/school, and class sessions will be halted until fixed.

Note: Students must take responsibility for any • Beorganized. damage they cause and fix it immediately to avoid disrupting class.

10.2 Defamation

School policies protect students and the school. Any student who defames or sabotages the school will be expelled. The school must also prosecute the offender legally.

10.3 Stealing: GMYT takes theft seriously. Any student caught cheating will be expelled and prosecuted.

10.4 Uniform: Fridays are T-shirt days. No facilitator will assist a student who doesn't wear the T-shirt.

Extra Curricula Activities: Extracurricular activities cost money. Only interested students must pay this fee.

10.5 Classroom Policy

- All students are expected to read their class policies at all times.
- Students must submit their course form first thing before they go into the class.
- Punctual and Regular Students should plan arriving on time to avoid entering the class when class has started to avoid distracting the instructor and students.
- Contact the instructor when you have to miss class.
- Avoid walking out half way into the class
- Respect others.
- Be polite.
- Turn off or silent your cell phone.
- · Contribute to the class discussion when appropriate.
- Avoid side conversation.
- Be attentive in class
- No conniving.
- Address the instructors properly.
- No bullying of any kind.
- Ensure to maintain cleanliness in the class and also in the comfort.
- Avoid signaling, sending signs that class time is up.
- Be organized.
- Ensure to maintain cleanliness in the class and also in within the Academy.
- Ensure to always turn off the sewing machine, pressing iron and sockets after use.

10.6 Littering Of Classes, Executive Lounge And Cutting Room With Dirt:

Classrooms, cutting rooms, and VIP rooms must be clean. Students who disobey will be suspended.



10.6 Complaints: Students must write their complaints using the templates in their course form, print or give the photocopy to customer service or the accountant so it can be addressed officially. Verbal complaints are void in this organization. Please visit www.gmytfashionacademy.com for help line details to send queries or recommendations to the right office.

10.7 Dress Code: Students should wear business casual to school. Slippers and flipflops aren't allowed at school. Students should bring: Flats, heels, sneakers. Anyone not dressed properly was sent home.

10.8 Smoking: is prohibited in the school premises.

10.9. Vip Room: VIP room is off-limits for fabric cutting. The floor is unsuitable for cutting fabrics due to its nature.

10.10 Health Regulations

Students must follow the academy's Covid 19 protocols/regulations; those who don't will be expelled or sent to detention. Before entering school, students must show their vaccine card. No vaccination card, no entry.

10.11. Electronics: Electronics with high power consumption are not allowed in the Academy.

10.12. Use Of Air-conditioning: All air conditioners must be used with caution. Air conditioners should never be switched on in unoccupied rooms, and windows and doors must be closed while in use. This will assist the school save cost, create a pleasant learning atmosphere for all students and limit the possibility of equipment becoming damaged. Students who breach this policy will face disciplinary action.

10.13. Visitor: Student are not allowed to entertain guests at the academy during official hours.

10.14. Break Period: Solid foods aren't allowed in class, so students must go to the VIP room for breakfast, lunch, and snacks.

10.15. Nannies: Students with 0-1-year-old babies can bring nannies. Due to the nature of the classrooms, parents are responsible for their children and management is not. Parents must prevent class disruptions.

10.16. Social Responsibility: Before graduation, all students must participate. A student may be required to teach a foundation student as a volunteer. Graduation requires this.



FORCE MAJEURE

25. Force Majeure: All Students and guardians understand and agree that GMYT Fashion Academy's duties and obligations may be modified or suspended immediately and without notice due to force majeure causes beyond the Academy's reasonable control and occurring without its fault or negligence, including, but not limited to, acts of God, fire, wars, governmental action, terrorism, epidemic, pandemic, weather, other threats to people's safety, national emergencies, or any other event.

In such an event, the student agrees to continue paying tuition and other fees, and the Academy's duties and obligations may be modified, suspended, or postponed until GMYT Fashion Academy can safely resume operations.

The student agrees that the only remedy for force majeure is future service delivery, not a refund. GMYT Fashion Academy may change the academic year schedule or offer remote learning at its sole discretion.

PROMOTIONS

11. Brand Promotion: All alumni/student pictures/videos, projects, promotional materials, and others are property of the school.

STUDENT'S SIGNATURE

Promotional photos of students' class activities are common. No student should object to being photographed because it promotes the school/students.Except for assignments and projects, students can't make personal services at school.

11.1. Right To Student Group Projects: Every group project done by students is the property of the school.

DATA PROTECTION
